



2017 CPSIA Information for Liberty Holdings

Liberty Holdings and its subsidiaries: Liberty Bags, The Carmel Towel Company, Fortress, Hardware, and Alpine Fleece; have developed a program to ensure products for our company comply with The Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act (CPSIA) of 2008. Liberty Holdings and its subsidiaries CPSIA program includes random testing for all CPSIA regulated standards applicable to our products, including lead content in substrates, products containing certain phthalates and lead in paint and surface coating. Though some CPSIA issues remain open and fluid, Liberty Holdings wants to assure our customers that we are vigorously pursuing compliance with not only CPSIA, but all Federal and local regulations and that we have a comprehensive testing and documentation program in place.

Certain sections of the law do pertain to the Promotional Products Industry, specifically to those items classified as Children's Products. All of the items found in Liberty Holdings catalog are not designed to be used by children under the age of 12. Despite this, Liberty Holdings and its subsidiaries have undertaken testing campaigns to ensure that certain products that may appeal to children meet CPSIA requirements.

Liberty Holdings and its subsidiaries, utilizes accredited third party testing labs. These testing labs issue certificates to substantiate that the tested products meet all applicable CPSIA requirements. Testing reports are available upon request.
